Re: Weaver Farm Cemetery

Dear Doug:

Enclosed is a proposal for on-site topographic mapping and planning work for the Weaver Farm Cemetery site improvements. The topographic mapping would entail a site visit to record all elevations and surface features of the small cemetery. We would also set control points for elevational and horizontal layout control for any recommended site improvements.

As we discussed when we met at the site on 8/25/15, the goal of the planning work would be to better define and establish the perimeters of the cemetery and improve its general neatness/appearance without bringing undue attention to its presence for visitors to the casino and resort.

Because of the grade differential between the cemetery ground and the planned surrounding pavement, our initial thoughts are that a low "landscape-type" dry-set concrete block wall may be the best solution for grade resolution and definition. Inside the plot, a general cleanup, selective tree removal and overseeding with a non-mowed grass could improve the neatness without the need for intensive maintenance. The taller grass may also serve to obscure the memorials and better protect them from possible vandalism.

As recommended in the report by Richard Fishman that you gave to me, the cemetery and Weaver Family might also be recognized through a modest sign. We have used a photo-metallic sign company in the past that produces images on metal that are monochromatic and durable. The resulting signs are subtle in color and contrast, which would seem appropriate for the objectives.

If the decision is to move ahead with this work, a copy of the proposal with signature and the retainer may be forwarded to us. We will then coordinate a site visit with you. In the meantime, please let us know if you have questions.
