Thank you for requesting the comments of the Division for Historic Preservation of the Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP). We have reviewed the project plans and the Grever and Ward letter, dated September 14, 2015, regarding the proposed Weaver Cemetery site improvements, in accordance with the New York State Historic Preservation Act of 1980 (Section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law). These comments are those of the Division for Historic Preservation and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources. They do not include potential environmental impacts to New York State Parkland that may be involved in or near your project. Such impacts must be considered as part of the environmental review of the project pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (New York Environmental Conservation Law Article 8) and its implementing regulations (6NYCRR Part 617).

Based on this review, the OPRHP has no concerns with the approach outlined for the long-term care of the Weaver Cemetery. Therefore, we recommend that this project will have no adverse impact on archaeological and/or historical resources listed in or eligible for the New York State and National Registers of Historic Places.
