Relative to your inquiry regarding the disposition of sanitary sewer flows from the proposed Lago Resort & Casino we offer the following.


It is our understanding that the project will involve the construction of a private 6" force main from the project site, under the NYS Thruway and direct flows to the existing 12" gravity sanitary sewer located at the Petro site. The estimated average flow from the project is 145,000 gallons per day. It has been determined by our consulting engineers that there is sufficient capacity within the existing 12" gravity sewer to accept flows from the project without utilizing all of the capacity within this facility.

Based upon a November 2013 Engineering Feasibility Study prepared by Barton & Loguidice, in order to accept any future flows including those associated with the Lago project there will be required improvements further downstream of the 12" gravity sewer beginning at the Rt. 414 (Petro) pump station. These improvements generally consist of upgrades to the Rt. 414 pump station, construction of an 8" force main beginning just north of the Seneca Meadows pump station (bypassing this station and its associated force main) and discharging the new 8" force main into an existing 12" gravity sewer located just north of Route 5&20. Additionally some pump and electrical upgrades at the Kingdom Road pump station will also be required. Details of these Improvements can be found in Appendix G, Alternative No.1 – Phase 1B of the aforementioned Study.

It is our understanding that Whitetail 414/Wilmorite will fund the cost for these improvements as part of the project. With the upgrades as noted above the Town of Seneca Falls Sanitary Sewer District would accept and treat the flows associated with the Lago Resort & Casino project. Standard outside user rates will apply for billing purposes; agreement to be forthcoming.
