

Town of Tyre, New York
Town Board Minutes
February 17, 2011

The monthly meeting of the Town of Tyre Board was held Thursday, February 17, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. in the Highway Building. Following were Present: Councilmen Thomas Thompson, Joseph DeI Papa, James Rogers, absent - Supv. Patricia Amidon and Councilman Reginald Aceto. Also attending were: ZCEO/PBM Ronald McGreevy, Highway Supt. John Worden, Assessor Philip Griswold, Town Attorney Charles Shaffer, David and Maxwell Schoomaker.

Deputy Supervisor Thomas Thompson opened the meeting at 7:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Deputy Supv. Thompson called for a moment of silence in remembrance of former Magee Fire Department Chief Roger Waugh.

Maxwell Schoomaker attended the meeting to obtain credit toward a Boy Scout badge.

Highway – Hydroax

The Highway Supt. Spoke of the advantage of a Hydroax which is used on an excavator to trim brush from trees and mow behind guardrails.

The Highway Supt. Will attend a demonstration of a Hydroax at Phelps in the near future.

Highway – Striping Bill

Highway Supt. Worden brought attention to a bill he has received from the stripping company. The stripping company has charged the Town \$402.00 for additional paint they had to purchase.

The amount the Town was charged was more than the company price per mile. The Town has paid the bill in accordance with the figures in the contract.

Town Attorney Shaffer suggested that the company be notified that the Town Board stands by the voucher previously approved by the Town Board, and supports the action taken by the Highway Superintendent regarding the matter.

Assessment and Taxation

Assessor Griswold informed the Board that the seminar he attended in Rochester January 14th was one of the 4 or 5 seminars he attends each year to obtain the required 24 hours of Continuing Education Credits.

Planning and Zoning

PBM/ZCEO Ronald McGreevy stated that the Website went on line January 24th.

Mr. McGreevy will be working on a permit for the Mennonite School.

Minutes

Councilman DelPapa moved, seconded by Councilman Rogers and carried, that the minutes of January 20, 2011 be accepted as read.

Dogs – Shelter Agreement

Councilman Rogers moved, seconded by Councilman DelPapa, directing the Supervisor to enter into a contract agreement with the Beverly Animal Shelter, Inc. effective January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011. The

Tyre Water District #1

Fred Witt, Town of Junius Chief Water Systems Operator, has informed Supv. Amidon that effective January 1, 2011 the water rate will be \$2.83 plus .12 cents, the cost of pumping the water, for a total of \$2.95 per 1000 gallons for Tyre Water District #1.

Councilman DelPapa moved seconded by Councilman Rogers and carried, that General Fund bills numbering 14-24, Highway 31-35 and Water W1&2 be approved for payment.
