

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD FOR THE TOWN OF TYRE ESTABLISHING  
A RECORDS ACCESS APPEALS OFFICER**

**August 21, 2014**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Tyre periodically receives document requests pursuant to Sections 84-90 of the New York State Public Officers Law, known as the Freedom of Information Law (“FOIL”) and pursuant to Sections 100-111 of the Public Officers Law, known as the Open Meetings Law (“OML”); and

**WHEREAS**, some document requests may be denied by the Town’s records access officer or Clerk on the basis that the document or documents fall within an exception to the disclosure requirements found in the FOIL and OML; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board for the Town of Tyre desires to designate a records access appeals officer to review the denial of such document requests upon the submission of a timely appeal;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board designates the Town Attorney to serve as the Town of Tyre’s records access appeals officer.
