**WHEREAS**, LaBella Associates has submitted a written proposal dated March 31, 2022 for evaluation of the current water charging practices within the Town as described in Local Law #3 of 2002 “WATER SERVICE” and;

**WHEREAS**, the Tyre Town Board is cognizant of the fact that the current method is based on a “unit charge” rather than a straight commodity/usage charge which is customary with most municipal standards and;

**WHEREAS**, the Tyre Town Board finds the terms and conditions of the Proposal to be acceptable;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Proposal submitted by LaBella Associates dated March 31, 2022 for evaluation of the current water charging practices within the Town on the terms and conditions contained therein, a copy of which is attached hereto, is approved; and
