RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FROM BARTLETT WELL DRILLING TO DEVELOP A NEW SUPPLY WELL FOR THE TYRE HIGHWAY BUILDING

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Tyre has determined that it is in the Town's best interest to develop a new supply well for the Tyre Highway Building and;

WHEREAS, the Tyre Town Board is also cognizant of the Guidelines set forth in the Town of Tyre, NY Procurement Policy adopted with resolution on May 18, 2017 and readopted on January 6, 2022 and;

WHEREAS, the Tyre Town Board estimated the amount of the contract to be around \$10,000 requiring an RFP and 2 verbal quotations from Vendors/Contractors for contracts estimated to be between \$5,001 - \$10,000 or an RFP and 2 written quotations from Vendors/Contractors for contracts estimated to be between \$10,001 - \$20,000, and;

WHEREAS, the Tyre Town Board solicited four quotes to develop a new supply well for the Tyre Highway Building and two written quotations were received in response to the RFP and;

WHEREAS, Bartlett Well Drilling was the lowest bidder while meeting the required scope of work as defined in the RFP;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tyre Town Board does hereby award the bid to Bartlett Well Drilling, 3004 Tyler Road, Newark, NY 14513, in the lump sum of \$10,800 to develop a new supply well for the Tyre Highway Building; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tyre Town Board does hereby authorize and direct the Town Supervisor to sign all necessary documents to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
