  - June 17, 2022 - From NYSEG, news release regarding a new low-income utility arrears forgiveness program available to NYSEG and RG&E customers received via email.

- June 21, 2022 – Supervisor Partee attended a Local Government Budgeting seminar with the NYS Office of the State Comptroller.

Note: They are still waiting to receive the permanent light that will be installed in front of Love's (supply issues). The permanent light is needed to coordinate all the signals on 414 together.
